Air Conditioning Startup Completed

Honeycutt Air Conditioning completed a successful startup of the air conditioning system according to Tom Barron with the Bellville Turnverein Pavilion Restoration Project. Spencer Honeycutt, shown in the photo at the end of the table, was assisted by representatives from Mitsubishi, the AC equipment manufacturer.

The restrooms and catering kitchen have been painted and are nearing completion pending electrical build out, setting of toilet partitions in the restrooms, and sinks and countertops in the kitchen. Gaeke Construction will begin constructing new benches over the perimeter AC grills this week.

In addition to the above work, there are still a number of minor items to be completed so Mr. Barron says the revised goal is to finish the restoration work next month.
